One of the joys of making the projects in this book is that you don't need a lot of stuff. More happiness is that they're fun and easy. So after reading the next few pages, you'll know what materials to get and what you need to know to get started, and then you'll be all set for some feltie fun!

SUPPLIES

The materials listed below are used in all the projects, so you'll need to gather them before you begin. You probably have a lot of them already, and what you don't have won't cost you a bundle. You'll find a complete listing of the tools and materials needed for each felt set at the end of the project chapter, located with the patterns.

Felt

Not all felt is created equally. As a felt pattern designer, I've tried many different types. I find acrylic craft felt (made from a polyester blend of fibers) pulls at the stitches and can rip if you overstuff your item, while 100 percent wool felt is too thick. So I use 1 mm-thick wool blend felt. It's a bit more expensive than the acrylic kind but much more durable, and you'll want your feltie to hold up to lots of squeezing. If you're making something for a wee one, make sure the felt is baby/child safe.

You can purchase wool blend felt online and in some craft stores. I use Sunfelt felt (from Japan); the colors marked on each pattern piece is how the company identifies its colors, but the names are also descriptive and will assist you when choosing any brand of felt.

Scissors

Fabric scissors for cutting felt fabrics (make sure they're sharp!)
Paper scissors for cutting cardboard and other materials
Eyebrow scissors for snipping and cutting tiny pieces

Sewing Needles

No particular length or thickness is required. All the projects are 100 percent hand-sewn, so use whatever works best for you.

Sewing Thread

Nothing fancy, use standard 60-weight sewing threads that are typically used for sewing by hand or machine. Choose colors that closely match those of your felt fabrics.

Ruler

For the most accurate measurements, make sure you have one that shows centimeters; many of them do. In a few instances, a pattern was too large to run at actual size so I've indicated the measurements on the pattern. Just measure and draw the lengths onto your felt.

Pencils & Markers

Use a #2 pencil for most light fabrics. For darker fabrics such as black and brown, use a 0.5 white color marker pen or chalk pencil.

Stuffing

Fiberfill or polyfill works best for maximum fluffiness. Cotton stuffing makes the item lumpy (not a good look) and will not go back into shape like fiberfill does when pressed.



OTHER MATERIALS

Some of the felties require a few additional materials other than the ones just listed. Be sure to check the Supplies list for each project to determine exactly what you'll need.

Nylon thread

Non-toxic quick dry craft glue

Metal sheets

(available at craft stores)

Magnet buttons

Aluminum wire

Cardboard/posterboard

(purchase at craft stores or use the cardboard from packaged grocery items like cereal boxes)

PVC plastic sheet

(you can buy this at craft stores or use the clear report covers found at office supply stores.)

Long tweezers or a chopstick

Wire/metal sheet cutter

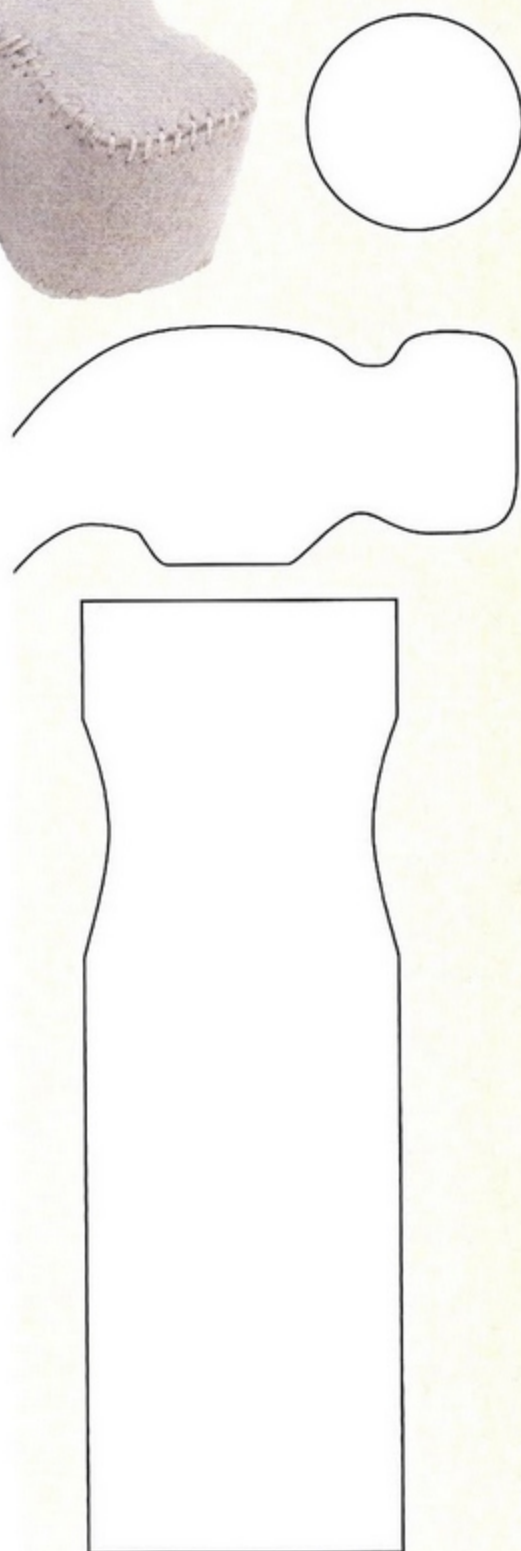

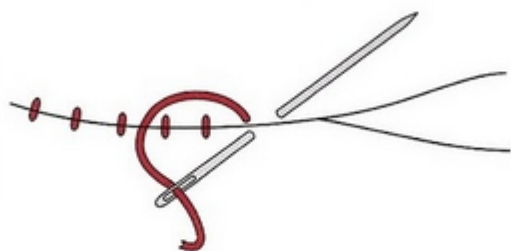
HOW TO USE THE PATTERNS IN THIS BOOK

Most of the patterns are shown at actual size so they require no pesky enlarging. In the rare cases where a pattern is marked with ✱, measure and cut the felt pieces according to the measurements given on the pattern piece. Not to worry, these pattern pieces are all simple squares or rectangles.

Photocopy or trace each pattern piece onto paper and then cut it out. Trace the pattern onto your felt. Once you've cut out your felt pieces, leave the paper patterns on top of them for easy identification.



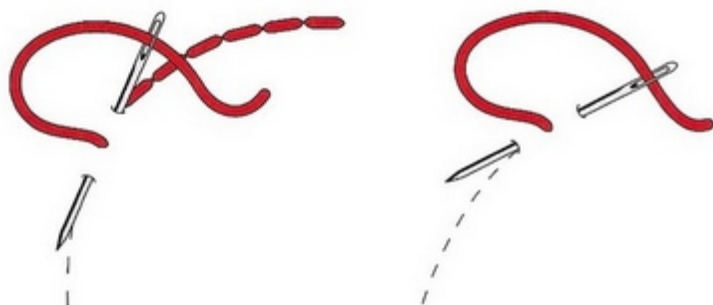

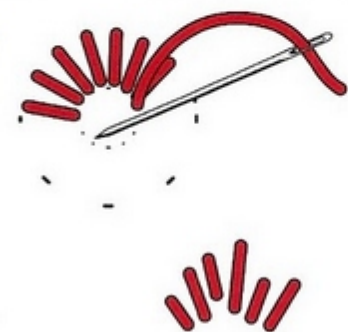

STITCHES USED

Just five simple stitches were used to make the projects in this book. Unless otherwise stated in the instructions, the default stitch is always the Whip Stitch.

Whip Stitch

Whip Stitch is the most commonly used stitch. It's perfect for sewing two pieces of felt fabric together in order to create round shapes. It's normally used with thread color that matches your felt so an advantage is any uneven stitches won't be very obvious.

Blanket Stitch

Blanket Stitch is used mostly on flat edges to neaten them. It can also be used as a decorative stitch using different colored thread, but you'll need to make sure your stitches are even.

Backstitch

Back Stitch is used to define details and to outline shapes.

French Knot

French Knots are usually used to define details and outline shapes.

Straight Stitch

Straight Stitch (aka Running Stitch) is actually individual stitches sewn without crossing or looping the thread. It looks like a broken line. It's easily removable and thus sometimes used to tack two pieces of fabric together temporarily.





TIPS & POINTERS

I've created a lot of felties over time and have learned a thing or two that you might find helpful.

Tracing & Cutting

> Did you know that felt has vertical and horizontal sides? The side that stretches when pulled is horizontal. When cutting, be sure to match the sides, otherwise the felt may stretch and change shape when stuffed.

> To trace the patterns, place a pattern piece on the felt, trace around it lightly with a pencil, and cut the traced shape out.

> Cut out each felt pattern lovingly piece by piece. Do not attempt to stack and cut the felt together at once.

> Don't rush. Cut your felt pattern pieces accurately. Inaccurate felt pieces might result in the final item being out of shape.

> Smooth uneven felt surfaces with an iron before tracing and cutting.

Sewing

> For sewing and attaching pieces together, choose a thread color similar to that of your felt and work with double strands of thread. This makes for stronger, cleaner stitches.

> When sewing felt pieces together, take care not to pull too hard or the surface will become wavy.

> If you make a mistake and need to re sew, you can fill the needle holes by gathering fibers from the surrounding surface area using the tip of a needle.

Stuffing

> Stuff the item bit by bit, filling up the sides first, then the center.

> Use tweezers or a stick to stuff smaller parts where your fingers can't reach.

Cleaning & Washing

> Wool blend felt can be washed. Although it can be machine washed, I'd recommend handwashing your feltie. Be aware that the piece will shrink about 10 percent.

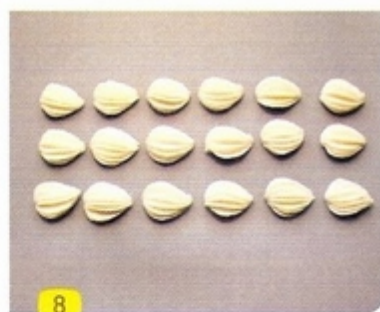
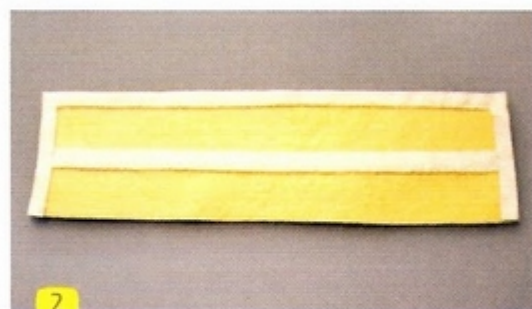
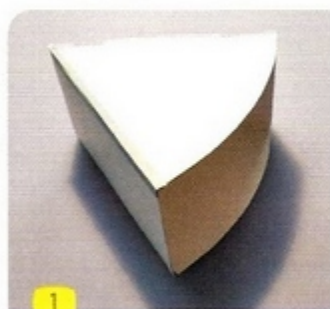
> You can spot clean a feltie using cellophane tape. Rub the adhesive side over the surface to remove any unwanted markings or fibers.

- 1 Tape the **cardboard** Cake Top, Base, Side, and Back together.
- 2 Sew the Cake Center pieces to the Cake Side.
- 3 Stitch the Cake Top and Base to the Cake Side, then sew the Cake Back to the Top, leaving an opening as shown.
- 4 Insert the **cardboard** form into the cake, fill with stuffing, and sew the opening closed. Repeat the same for the other five slices.

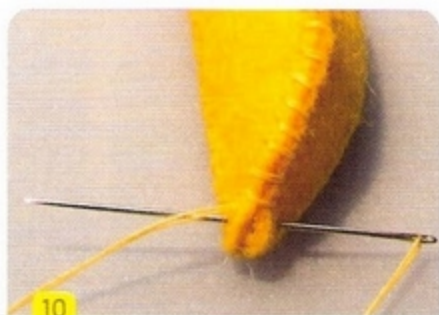
- 5 Place eight Whipped Cream pieces together as shown.
- 6 Turn the stack over, pinch the straight side together, and over stitch using **WHITE** thread.
- 7 Turn the piece over and spread out the Whipped Cream evenly.
- 8 Repeat steps 5 through 7 for the remaining 17 Whipped Creams. Sew three Whipped Creams to the edge of the Cake Slice. Repeat for the other slices.





PLATTER

- 9 Sew the two pieces of the Cake Platter together halfway and then insert the two **cardboard** Cake Platter pieces in between. Stitch up the opening.



PEACH

- 10 Sew the Peach Side and End together, filling with stuffing. Repeat for the rest of the Peach Slices.



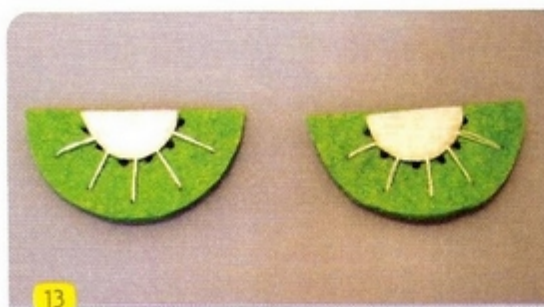
ORANGE

- 11 Stitch the details onto the Orange Slice as shown.



- 12 Stitch two Orange Slices together, filling with stuffing. Repeat for the rest of the Orange Slices.

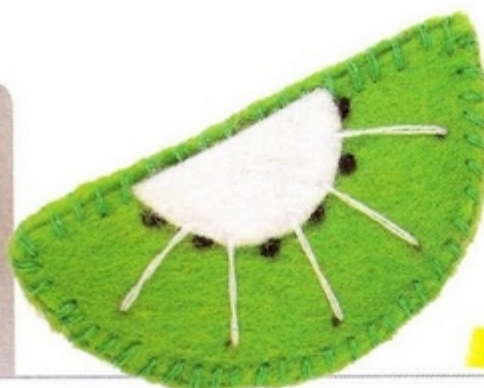

- 13 Sew the Kiwi Center onto the Kiwi Slice and stitch on the details as shown.

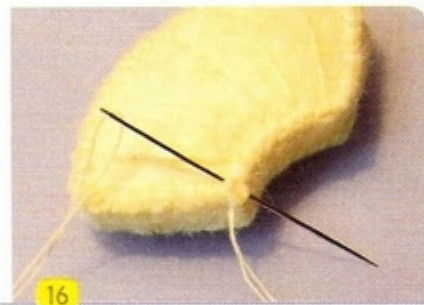
- 14 Sandwich a Kiwi Side between two Kiwi Slices and stitch together, filling with stuffing. Repeat for the rest of the Kiwi Slices.

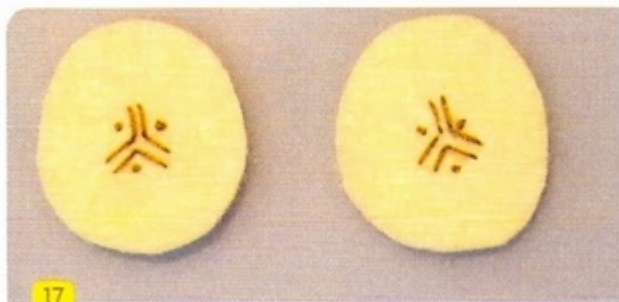

- 15 Stitch the details on the Pineapple Slices as shown.

- 16 Sandwich a Pineapple Side between two Pineapple Slices and stitch together, filling with stuffing. Repeat for the rest of the Pineapple Slices.

BANANA

- 17 Stitch the details on the Banana Slice as shown.

- 18 Sandwich a Banana Side between two Banana Slices and stitch together, filling with stuffing. Repeat for the rest of the Bananas.

STRAWBERRY



- 19 Attach the Strawberry Center to the Slice and stitch the details as shown. Sew the Side between two Slices, filling with stuffing. Repeat for the rest of the Strawberries.



RASPBERRY



- 20 Stitch around the edge of the Raspberry, leaving the thread ends loose.

- 21 Pull both ends of the threads, fill with stuffing, and fasten the thread ends with knots. Trim away the excess threads.

- 22 Sew vertical lines on the Raspberry.

- 23 Sew horizontal lines.

- 24 Sew the Base to the Raspberry, covering the opening. Repeat for the rest of the raspberries.



BLUEBERRY

- 25 Cut the "X" on the Blueberry and glue the Blueberry center on top.

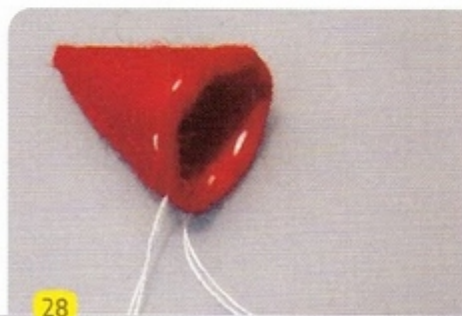
- 26 Repeat steps 20 and 21 for the Blueberry.

- 27 Sew the Base to the Blueberry, covering the opening. Repeat the same for the rest of the Blueberries.

28 Sew the side of the Candle Flame together. Stitch around the edge with a running stitch, leaving the thread ends loose.

29 Fill the Flame with stuffing and then pull and tie both ends of the threads together. Trim off the excess threads.

30 Roll up the Candle (on the longer side), and twirl white thread around it as shown.

31 Stitch the Flame onto the Candle.

32 Sew the hook-and-loop Candle Base to the bottom of the Candle. Repeat steps 28 through 32 for the rest of the Candles.

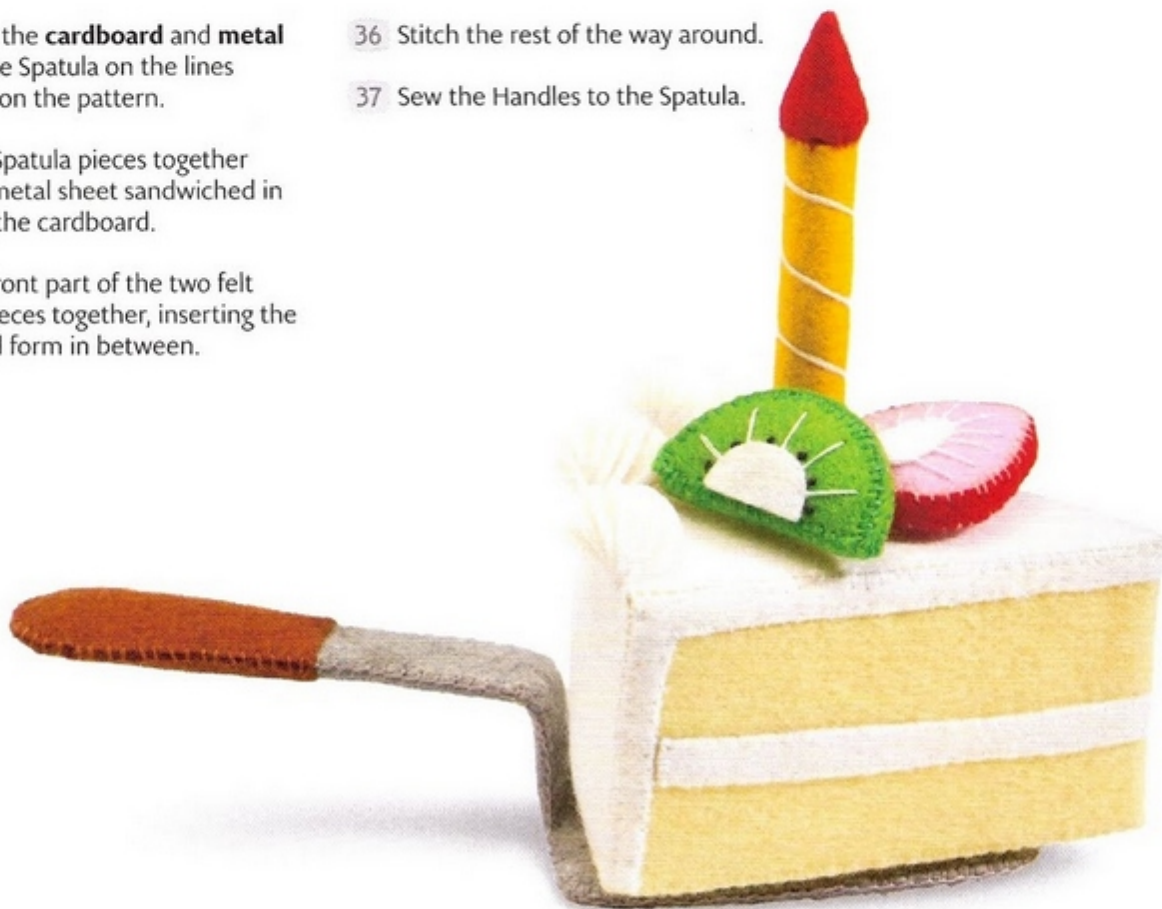
33 Fold both the **cardboard** and **metal sheet** Cake Spatula on the lines indicated on the pattern.

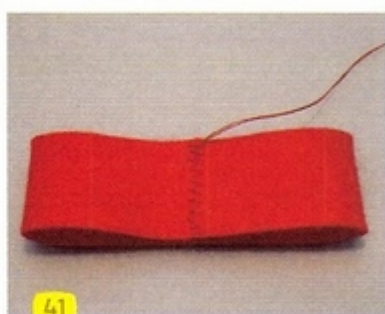
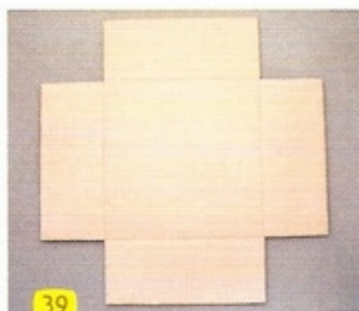
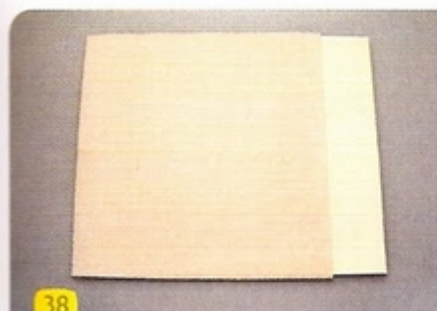
34 Tape the Spatula pieces together with the metal sheet sandwiched in between the cardboard.

35 Sew the front part of the two felt Spatula pieces together, inserting the cardboard form in between.

36 Stitch the rest of the way around.

37 Sew the Handles to the Spatula.





38 Sew three sides of the Cake Box Base together, then insert the cardboard Cake Box Base and stitch the opening closed.

39 Repeat the previous step to make the Cake Box Base Sides. Sew them together as shown.

40 Repeat steps 38 and 39, substituting the Cake Box Top pieces for the Cake Box Base pieces. Fold the Box Top Sides up and stitch at the corners.

41 Sew the ends of the Ribbon Bow Layer 1 together and flatten it such that the stitches are at the center as shown. Repeat with the other piece.

42 Turn each Ribbon Bow Layer 1 over and stitch the center together as shown. Repeat steps 41 and 42 for the Ribbon Bow Layer 2 pieces.

43 Sew the Bow pieces together at the center as shown.

44 Sew the sides of the Ribbon Bow Center together and flatten it down.

45 Assemble and sew all the Ribbon Bow pieces together as shown.

46 Glue the Ribbon on top of the Cake Box cover as shown.

47 Glue the Ribbon Bow at the center.

1 Stitch the wood grain details on all of the Log and Log Ends as shown.

2 Sew the sides of the log together.

3 Sew one Log End on.

4 Sew on the other Log End, leaving an opening for stuffing.

5 Fill the log with stuffing and stitch up the opening.

6 Repeat steps 1 through 5 for the other two logs.

FIRE



7 Sew the Inner, Middle, and Outer Zones of the fire together as shown.

8 Repeat the previous step two more times.

9 Apply glue generously to the backs of the fire pieces.

10 Glue the backs of the fire together as shown.

11 Stitch the edges of the fire with a blanket stitch, and leave to dry.

13 Stitch the details onto the Compass Top as shown.

14 Sew the Compass Side and Compass Base together.

15 Insert a **cardboard** Compass Base into the bottom of the compass.

16 Sew the Compass Top on halfway.

17 Fill the compass with stuffing, insert the other **cardboard** Base on top of the stuffing, and stitch the opening closed.

18 Sew down through the Compass Center into the ends of the red then the black Compass Needles, and straight through the center of the Compass Top as shown.

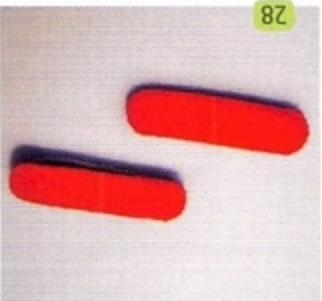

20 Place the **cardboard** Blade in between the two felt Blade pieces and sew them together.

21 Repeat step 20 for the Bottle Opener and the Can Opener/Screwdriver.

22 Sew three-quarters of the way around the felt Casing pieces, then insert the **cardboard** Casing pieces as shown. Set them aside.

23 Sew the two felt Casing Base pieces together with the **cardboard** Casing in between.

24 Fold back the felt and stitch the Can Opener to one of the Casings at the unsewn end, as shown (see next photo for details).

25 Sew the openings on both casings closed.

26 Tie a few knots to make sure the stitches are fastened to the **cardboard**.

27 Stitch the Blade and Bottle Opener to the other Casing using the same method as above.

28 Poke your needle through the cardboard Casing and stitch the Can Opener to only the **cardboard**. Tie a few knots to fasten the stitch.

29 Sandwich the **cardboard** Casing Base pieces and stitch the piece to the casing, curving the piece as you go.

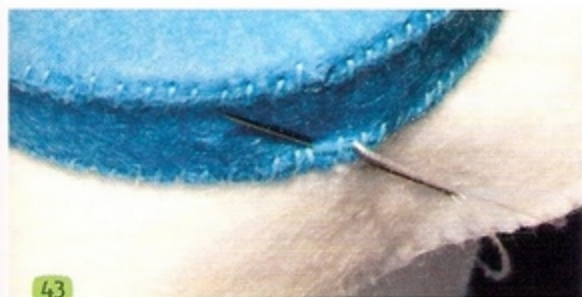
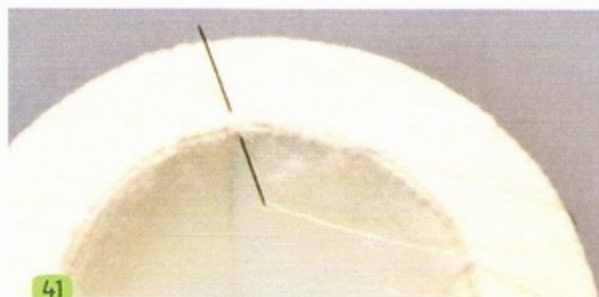

- 41 Sew the inner part of the Collar to the Top of the Screen.
- 42 Fill the Screen with stuffing.
- 43 Sew the Cap on.
- 44 Sew the Top, Base, and Side of the Control Knob together, leaving an opening for stuffing. Stuff and finish sewing together.
- 45 Sew the Control Knob onto the base as shown.
- 46 Sew the edges of the two Handle pieces together using a blanket stitch.
- 47 Sew the Handle to the Cap.



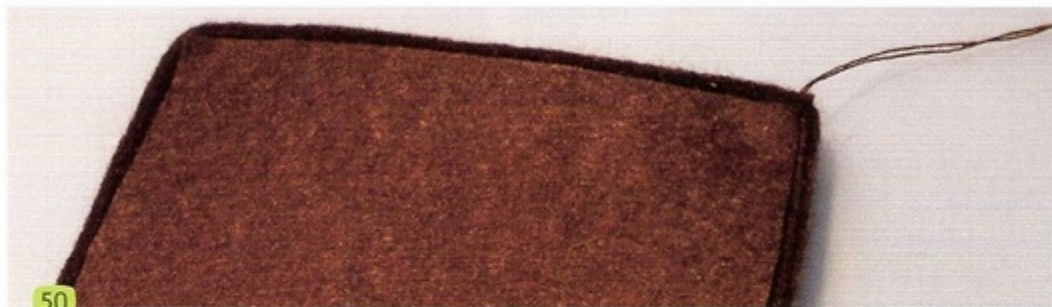

- 48 Stack three Graham Cracker pieces and sew three of the sides together. Sew French knots on the cracker as shown. Repeat the same process to make the other cracker.
- 49 Sew the Chocolate Bar Sides to one piece of the Chocolate Bar.
- 50 Place two Chocolate Bar pieces inside as shown.
- 51 Place the last piece on top and sew the sides together.
- 52 Sew the Marshmallow Top, Base, and Side together, leaving an opening.

- 53 Fill the marshmallow with stuffing.
- 54 Sew up the opening. Stack the marshmallow and chocolate bar in between the graham crackers.

- 3 Using a running stitch, sew 2 to 3mm from the edge of the Strawberry Ice Cream, leaving the thread ends loose.
- 4 Pull both ends of the threads together and fasten the threads with knots.
- 5 Fill the Ice Cream with stuffing and trim off the excess threads.

- 6 Stitch the Strawberry Ice Cream Base over the opening.
- 7 Repeat the same for the Chocolate and Vanilla Ice Cream scoops. Sew the appropriate Syrup onto the top of each Ice Cream as shown.

- 8 Repeat steps 3 through 6 to make the Cherry.

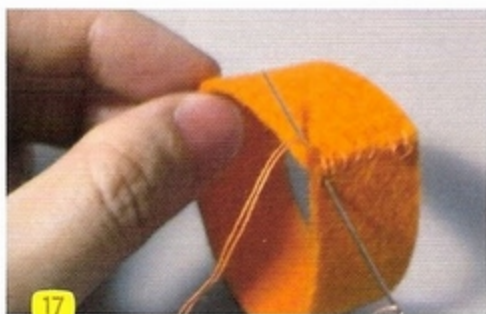
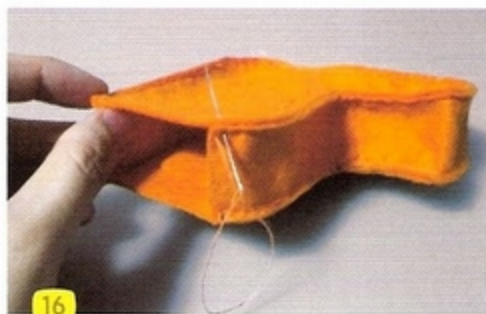
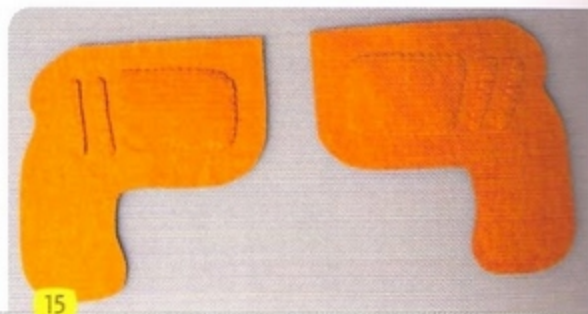


TOOL BELT



- 1 Fold the Big Pocket Bias in half and sew it to the big pocket as shown.
- 2 Fold the sides of the Big Pocket in as shown.

- 5 Your Big Pocket should look like this at this stage.
- 6 Draw two parallel lines on the big pocket according to the measurements as shown.
- 7 Pin down and sew the Small Pocket to the line.
- 8 Repeat the same for the other side (note: there will be "extra" felt).
- 9 Fold both sides of the small pocket and sew the bottom on as shown.
- 10 Draw two more parallel lines according to measurement as shown.
- 11 Sew the sides of the Hammer Holder as shown.
- 12 Fold the Belt Slot in half and pin it to the top of the big pocket as shown. Sew the Belt Slot on. Insert a belt into the Belt Slot.

DRILL



15 Sew the Fan Coolers to the Drill Housings as shown.

16 Using a backstitch, sew the Drill Housing Side to the wrong-side of the Drill Housings.
