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Introduction

What I wanted to teach you in this book is how to take a basic pattern and change it to make a completely different looking bracelet. In other words, learn to design your own stylish bracelet. You will also learn a wonderful variety of techniques while working through the bracelets in this book; such as net weave, peyote, right angle weave, chevron chain and square stitch. You will learn these stitches while creating a whole wardrobe of bracelets. As an added bonus, by creating the variations shown in this book, you will also “learn to create”. You will visually see how adding variations to a basic design can change the look to create original designs unique to each.

Create fabulous bracelets that are beautiful and fashionable using the addition of crystals, cube beads, Tila and/or Bugle beads in every pattern. With step-by-step instructions, full color detailed illustrations and color photographs it is possible for beginners to advanced beaders to complete each project with ease. Bracelets are fast and fun to make for all levels of bead weavers.

I hope you enjoy making all the wonderful bracelets in this book.

Chapter 1: Getting Started With Bead Weaving

Supplies Needed

Beads



There are thousands of different beads available in the market. Go to any beading store and you will get just a small look at what is available.

What I am showing here are the beads that I will be using in this book.

All my patterns are designed using Miyuki® seed beads. These seed beads are actually more donut shaped. I like to use these Japanese seed beads because they are uniform in size

and the holes are large and even and wide enough to go through with thread several times.

Of course, you can use any kind of seed beads, but some of the patterns might need to be adjusted. Do a small section first to see how your seed beads will work.



Miyuki® seed beads are Round Rocaille beads that come in a large variety of colors and sizes.



Miyuki® Tila beads are flat two-holed glass seed beads. They are made by Miyuki and they measure 5mm x 5mm x 1.9mm, and are sometimes described as a chiclet shape



Miyuki® Triangle beads have rounded corners and also come in a large variety of colors and finishes



Miyuki® Bugle beads are longer than they are thick, creating a tubular shape. They have different lengths but often range from 1/2" to 2" in length, and may be twisted also.



Miyuki® Delica beads are like small cylinders, with straight sides, and large round holes. They fit together very well in stitches such as peyote stitch, brick stitch and herringbone.



Miyuki® Cube beads are Japanese-made 4mm cubes. These are lovely beads to work with. The holes in these beads are fairly generous - about .065 inch, approx. 16 gauge, will take multiple strands of heavy thread.



Miyuki® 3.4mm Fringe Seed Bead are glass tear drops. These seed beads feature a teardrop shape with the stringing hole drilled through the top of the shape, allowing these seed beads to add a little bit of dangling style to your designs.



Faceted Leaded Crystal Beads are glass with a lead content of at least one percent is regarded as crystal, and the quality of crystal is entirely determined by its lead content in the US jewelry industry; the higher the lead content is, the better its quality.



Czech Fire-Polish Faceted Oval are shimmering faceted beads that sparkle just like leaded crystal but at a fraction of the cost. These beautiful beads from the Czech Republic are machine faceted, and then polished by glazing inside a red-hot oven.

Other Supplies Needed



Scissors For cutting beading thread you will need a small, very sharp scissors. Invest in a good one, it is worth it. For cutting Fireline, I would suggest a small child's scissors with a sharp tip. You can usually find these at the Dollar store.



Thread Look for is a beading thread with a weight of D. My favorites are Nymo and C-Lon thread. Nymo Thread consists of non-twisted fiber filament and C-Lon Bead Thread is a nylon monochord thread. These threads are not too heavy and not too thin. Match the color of thread to the color of beads that are in your bracelet.



I have recently started using ***Fireline® fishing line***, too. I like 4lb and 6lb for bead weaving. You do not need to stretch or wax it. Fireline comes in a smoky black and also crystal color. Fireline is a pre-waxed braided bead thread made from gel-spun polyethylene and is one of the strongest threads available. It is stretch resistant and knots easily. Check out your local fishing store or favorite discount store for the best prices.



Clear Nail Polish Dritz Fray Check or June Tailor Fray Block are also great options. The Fray check has a great tip for applying. Nail polish or the Fray Check is used for holding your knots and your threads in place. Only use fresh clear polish. Note: If you are using dyed beads, check for color fastness before using the polish. Sometimes the color from the beads can become removed.



Needles Beading needles come in different lengths and sizes. You will need sizes #11 and #12 beading needles. Beading needles are very similar to sewing needles. The difference is that the beading needles are much thinner and have smaller eyes. You can't pass through a seed bead with a sewing needle. You will choose the needle according to the type of beads, the thread size, and the type of project you will do. For example, if you are using seed beads size 15°, which are the smallest beads, it is ideal that you use at least a beading needle #12. Or

if the seed bead 11° is the smallest bead of your work, you can use a beading needle #11 or #10. They come in short and long versions. I use the John James English beading needles Sharps. I prefer the short, but it really makes no difference if you use either one. Needles are not that expensive, so when you are starting, pick a couple different lengths so you can try them. Use what is comfortable to you.



Beeswax is used for conditioning your thread. This is very important, especially with Nymo thread. It can also help to keep your thread from tangling. You can get it from any beading store or from any fabric store. The fabric stores usually sell beeswax in a round plastic container.

Portable Work Area



This is how I move around the house with what I am working on.

I first start with a lap desk. This is a flat board, about 12" x 10", attached to a pillow. Cut a piece of no-slip vinyl shelf liner to fit (this keeps the tray in place, even if you have to get up really fast) and put that on the lap desk. Then a tray, you do not want the tray to have edges that are too high, otherwise it will bother your arm if you are working on your lap.

Next, add another piece of shelf liner and finally a place mat. I use a tightly woven placemat so the beads don't get lost in the texture of the fabric. It also keeps the beads from bouncing at you when you are working. If I am working at a table, I just use the tray part. If I am working on my lap, I use the whole set up.



This is how I lay out my work surface.

I bring the needle to the beads on the tray when picking up, not the beads to the needle. The little silver spoon I use for scooping up beads to put them away.

Terminology


These are the terms that I use in this book.

FB = Foundation Bracelet

BFB = Bottom Foundation Bracelet

TFB = Top Foundation Bracelet


Each pattern tells you the type of beads that are used for the pattern.




Pick up, is used for the amount and type of beads that you pick up on your working needle and thread. The picture below shows, Pick up 4A, 1B, 3A

Go with thread

Go with thread refers to your working thread and needle.



Go forward, is to go with your working thread and needle in the same direction as all the steps have gone. Go up and down are simply up or down.




The Half Hitch Knot

To make a half hitch knot, go around the thread in the necklace with your working thread and needle between 2 beads. Make a loop and go through the loop in the working thread, pull up to tighten.

Please note: When weaving your threads through areas in the necklace that already have been done, try not to split the threads with your working needle as it can weaken the strength of your threads.

Bringing in New Thread and ending the old thread



When you start to run out of thread or if you see that your working thread is starting to fray, it is time to bring a new thread in and end the old thread.

The blue line in the diagram represents the finished working thread. Go with thread back through several beads in the bracelet. Make a half hitch knot. Weave again with your working thread through several more beads in the bracelet and make another half hitch knot, but before pulling up the thread to tighten the knot, put a bit of clear nail polish or Fray Check on the knot area and about 1/4" along the thread. Pull the knot up tight and continue with the working thread through several more beads in the bracelet. Trim off the thread as closely as possible to the beads in the bracelet.

Please note: If the bracelet has more than one row, you can weave the working thread through the bracelet beads and leave it without putting in the knot until the next row is complete. If you make a knot and you need to go through the bead where the knot is, the bead hole will be blocked. You can go back later to do the knotting. You never want to force the needle through beads because the beads are made of glass and can be broken.

The red line in diagram represents bringing in a new thread with a stopper bead. The stopper bead can be removed after several steps have been completed in the bracelet pattern. Pull off the stopper bead and weave off the end of the new thread in the opposite direction of the old thread.


Start Your Bracelet

Cut about 1 to 1-1/2 yard of thread.


When you get more experienced, you can start with a longer thread. When you cut the thread, cut it on an angle. This makes it easier to thread into the needle.

Run the thread through the beeswax a couple of times. Then run the thread through your fingers and stretch the thread as you are rubbing off the excess wax. DO NOT skip the stretching of the thread part. This is a big mistake that beginners make, including myself when I began. If you don't stretch the thread, after wearing your bracelet for a while, the thread will start to stretch on its own with the weight of the beads and the tension will become too loose. As you are making your bracelet keep your tension in mind. You don't want the tension too tight, but you also don't want to see the thread. If this is your first attempt at bead weaving, start by doing a small section of bracelet first.

Thread your beading needle. Pinch the thread between your thumb and finger, then bring the thread to the eye of the needle. Beading needle holes are very small, so it takes a bit of patience when you first start to thread them.



Whether using thread or fishing line, for ease in threading the beading needle use a permanent marker and touch the tip of the thread. The marker makes the end of the thread more visible and it also stiffens the end of the thread so that it goes more easily into the needle hole.



Next, add a stopper bead to the end of the working thread. I use an over-hand knot, so the bead will hold, but will also slide off easily. This bead can be a different color to help you remember that it is not part of the bracelet. The stopper bead is used to hold your beads on when you are starting a bracelet and keeps your tension.

Pick up the stopper bead, slide it down to the end of your working thread, leaving at least an 8" tail (this thread tail will be used later to add your closure). With the thread, make a loop over your stopper bead bringing the left end thread over and through the back of the right hand thread. Pull up ends so the thread is snug around the stopper bead.

When the bracelet is complete, you can pull the stopper bead off. Put the blunt end of your needle through the bead and pull it off by sliding the bead down the thread tail.

Finishing Your Bracelet




Adding a Closure

There are many kinds of clasps available, from very expensive to very cheap. Always try to match your closure to your bracelet. Don't use a cheap clasp for a bracelet that has taken you many hours to complete and has expensive beads in it.



If you search the web, you can find tons of instructions on how to make your own closure. Be creative and try to come up with your own ideas. If it doesn't work, you can always redo it. This is another spot where you can use your own design ideas. After finishing your bracelet, but before you add your closure, end your working threads. Then bring in a new thread to create your own custom created closure. If it doesn't work, it is easy to remove and redo using only the new added thread.

I personally like the "My Favorite Closure" or the button closure, found on the following pages. Both of these types of closures can match your bracelet perfectly. You don't have to rush out to the store to match your closure to your bracelet, you can make it yourself.



To add a Clasp


With the working thread from the bracelet, pick up 3* seed beads (*or as many or as few as you would like), closure (I put my clasps on a jump ring first), 3* seed beads, go with thread through 2 or 3 beads in bracelet. Continue with your working thread around and through all the closure beads several times.

You want to fill the beads with thread for strength. Continue with thread into the bracelet and end the thread.

Repeat in the same manner at the other end after removing the stopper bead. Use the stopper bead tail thread to add the other end of the closure.


You will have to work your thread differently depending on how the end of your toggle is. You can also use a split ring (or jump ring). Please see samples below

To add Toggle



With the working thread from the bracelet, pick up 11* seed beads (*or as many or as few as you would like), go with thread through 2 or 3 beads in bracelet. Remember that your toggle will have to fit through a loop of beads or the round end of the toggle closure, so you will want to use enough beads that you can turn the toggle while it is on your wrist. Continue with your working thread forward through half of the loop of beads, go through the toggle end, back through 1 bead in bead loop, around the toggle end again, and then continue around the loop of beads. Continue with thread through all the closure beads several times. You want to fill the beads with thread and through the toggle end for strength. Continue with thread into the bracelet and end the thread. Please look closely at the illustration above to see how I went with thread around the toggle end.

Repeat in the same manner at the other end after removing the stopper bead. Use the stopper bead tail thread to add the other end of the closure. If you would like, instead of using the loop that comes with the toggle closure, you can make your own loop of beads to match your bracelet.




You will have to work your thread differently depending on how the end of your toggle is. You can also use a split ring (or jump ring). Please see samples below.


My Favorite Closure




The toggle and loop




1. To make the toggle, Start a new thread, add a stopper bead, leaving a 10" tail. Rows 1 and 2: Pick up 7 seed beads, go with thread right to left through the 5th seed bead and pull up so the beads are stacked on top of each other as shown in drawing.




2. Row 3: Pick up 1 seed bead, skip over the next seed bead, go with thread, right to left through the next seed bead and pull up thread so the beads are stacked on top of each other as shown in drawing. Repeat one more time.




3. Row 4: Pick up 1 seed bead, go with thread, left to right through the next seed bead in Row 3, pull up thread. Repeat two more times.




4. Row 5: Pick up 1 seed bead, go with thread right to left through the next seed bead in Row 4, and pull up thread. Repeat to other end.



5. Rows 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10, repeat steps 4 or 5 to make 5 more rows.




6. Roll the small piece into a tube. With the working thread, weave across from the 10th row into the 1st row, going back and forth between the beads like a zipper. With the working thread weave through the beads in the tube, so your thread can come out the other end.




7. a) Pick up 1 crystal (to match bracelet) and 1 seed bead, go with thread back down through the crystal and the center of the tube.

b) Pick up 1 crystal and 1 seed bead, go with thread back down through the crystal and the center of the tube. Continue with thread as many times going through the beads added in step (a) and (b) of this step and the center of the tube. When you can't go through the beads any more, continue with thread into the beads in the tube and end the thread. Toggle made. Do not cut off the working thread. It can be used to attach the toggle to the bracelet.




This step shows you how to add your toggle to the bracelet. Pick up 4 beads; go with thread into the end beads in the bracelet. You can go through as many or as few beads in the bracelet as you wish. If there is a crystal at the end, go through the crystal and 1 or 2 seed beads. Pick up 4 beads; go with thread through 2 seed beads in the middle of the toggle. Continue with thread around through all these beads as many times as you can. When done, weave thread into the bracelet and end.




To make the loop, remove the stopper bead on the bracelet, put the end thread on your needle. Pick up 8 seed beads and go with thread through any seed beads in the bracelet. Continue with thread around and through the 1st through 5th seed beads just added. Pick up 20 - 23 seed beads (make a loop with the beads to see if they fit over the toggle), go with thread up through the 4th and 5th seed beads in the previous loop you just made. Check again to make sure the loop fits over the toggle. Continue with thread through all the loop beads as many times as you can. When done, weave thread into the bracelet and end.

Button and Loop Closure




To make the loop, remove the stopper bead on the bracelet, put the end thread on your needle. Pick up 6 seed beads and go with thread through 2 seed beads in the bracelet. Continue with thread around and through the 1st through 4th seed beads just added. Pick up 20 seed beads (make a loop with the beads to see if they fit over the button, adjust the number of seed beads if you need more or less to fit over the button), go with thread down through the 3rd and 4th seed beads in the previous loop you just made. Check again to make sure the loop fits over the button. Continue with thread through all the loop beads as many times as you can. When done, weave thread into the bracelet and end.

The Button and Loop closure is nice to use for another option. You can match even your button to your bracelet.



To add a button, with working thread pick up 4 seed beads, button, 4 seed beads (the number of seed beads can be changed to fit your button), go with working thread up or down into 2 or 3 seed beads in your bracelet. Continue with thread around through all the seed beads as many times as you can. When done, weave thread into the bracelet and end.



To make the loop, remove the stopper bead on the bracelet, put the end thread on your needle. Pick up 6 seed beads and go with thread through 2 seed beads in the bracelet. Continue with thread around and through the 1st through 4th seed beads just added. Pick up 20 seed beads (make a loop with the beads to see if they fit over the button, adjust the number of seed beads if you need more or less to fit over the button), go with thread down through the 3rd and 4th seed beads in the previous loop you just made. Check again to make sure the loop fits over the button. Continue with thread through all the loop beads as many times as you can. When done, weave thread into the bracelet and end.


1. Pick up 5A, 1B, go with thread down through the 1st A bead just added.




2. Pick up 3A, go with thread up through the 5th A bead added in the last step.




3. Pick up 4A, 1C, go with thread down through the 3rd A bead added in step #2 or step #6.




4. Pick up 4A, go with thread up through the 4th A bead added in the last step.



5. Pick up 3A, 1B, go with thread down through the 4th A bead added in step #4.



6. Pick up 3A, go with thread up through the 3rd A bead added in the last step.



7. Continue bracelet by repeating steps #3 through #6 until you reach the length that you would like your bracelet to be. Add closure of your choice.







1. Make 2 Daisy Net Foundation Bracelets. Do not end thread, leave the thread ends loose. Flip the second bracelet vertically as shown in illustration.




2. With working thread, follow the green dotted line in illustration around daisy, coming out with thread left to right through the 2 A beads as shown in illustration in the bottom Daisy Net bracelet. Pick up 1A, 1C, 1A, go with thread left to right through 2 A beads as shown in the top Daisy Net bracelet.




3. a) Pick up 1A, go with thread down through the 1 C bead added in step #2.


b) Pick up 1A, go with working thread by following the blue dotted line in illustration in the bottom Daisy Net bracelet, coming out with thread left to right through the top 2 A beads as shown.



4. Continue by repeating steps #2 and #3(a and b) along the center of the Daisy Net bracelets as show.



5. Pick up 6A, go with thread up through 1 A, 1 C and 1 A beads in bracelet, and forward through the 1st through 4th A beads just added in this step.



6. Add closures of your choice.


1. Make 1 Daisy Net Foundation Bracelet. Do not end thread, leave the thread ends loose.




2. Go right to left through the 2nd A bead in the FB, step #5 as shown. Pick up 4D, go with thread right to left through the 2nd A bead added in a repeat of step #3 in foundation bracelet (FB).




3. Pick up 4D, go with thread right to left through the 4th D bead, step #2, the 2nd A bead added in a repeat of step #3 in FB, and the 1st D bead just added in this step.




4. Pick up 3D, go with thread around and between the 2nd and 1st A beads, step #5 in FB, and up through the 3rd D bead just added in this step.




5. Pick up 3D, go with thread right to left through the 2nd A bead added in the next repeat left of step #3 in FB.




6. Pick up 4D, go with thread right to left through the 3rd D bead added in the last step, the 2nd A bead, step #3 in FB, and the 1st D bead just added in this step.




7. Pick up 3D, go with thread around and between the 2nd and 1st A beads, next repeat left of step #5 in FB, and up through the 3rd D bead just added in this step.




8. Continue top edge of bracelet by repeating step #5 through step #7, to the other end. Continue with working thread down through the 3rd, 2nd and 1st A beads, step #1 FB, and left to right through the 1st A bead, step #2 FB.




9. Pick up 4D, go with thread left to right through the 2nd A bead, step #4 FB.




10. Pick up 4D, go with thread left to right through the 4th D bead, step #9, the 2nd A bead, step #4 FB, and the 1st D bead just added in this step.




11. Pick up 3D, go with thread around and between the 2nd and 1st A beads, next repeat right of step #6 in FB, and down through the 3rd D bead just added in this step.




12. Pick up 3D, go with thread left to right through the 2nd A bead, in the next step #4 FB repeat to right.




13. Pick up 4D, go with thread left to right through the 3rd D bead, step #12, the 2nd A bead, step #4 FB, and the 1st D bead just added in this step.



14. Pick up 3D, go with thread around and between the 2nd and 1st A beads, next repeat right of step #6 in FB, and down through the 3rd D bead just added in this step.



15. Continue bottom edge of bracelet by repeating step #12 through step #14, to the other end. Continue with working thread up through the 2nd and 3rd A beads, step #6 FB, and the 3rd A bead, step #5 FB.



16. Add closures of your choice.


1. Make 2 Daisy Net Foundation Bracelets. Do not end thread, leave the thread ends loose. Flip the second bracelet vertically as shown in illustration.




2. Add center Beads as was done in Daisy Net Bracelet #2.




3. Add outside edge beads as was done in Daisy Net Bracelet #3. Weave the working thread into the center end crystal bead as shown.




4. Pick up 1D, 1E, 1D, go with thread down through the 1 C bead added in step #2 in the Daisy Net Bracelet Version #2.



5. Pick up 1D, 1E, 1D, go with thread down through the 1 C bead added in step #2, next repeat to the right, in the Daisy Net Bracelet Version #2.



6. Continue by repeating step #5 along the center of the bracelet as shown. Continue down through the 1A bead in bracelet.



7. a) Pick up 6A, go with thread down through 1 A, 1 C and 1 A beads in bracelet, and forward through the 1st through 4th A beads just added in this step.

b) Add closures of your choice on both ends.


1. Pick up 3A, go with thread forward through the 2nd and 3rd A beads just added in this step.




2. Pick up 1A, go with thread up through the 1st A bead, step #1, down through the 1 A bead just added in this step, up through the 1st and 2nd A beads, step #1, down through the 3rd A bead, step #1 and the 1 A bead just added in this step.




3. Pick up 1A, go with thread down through the 1 A bead, step #2, and up through the 1 A bead just added in this step.



4. Pick up 1A, go with thread down through the 3rd A bead, step #1, and up through the 1 A bead just added in this step.




5. Pick up 6A, go with thread up through the 1 A bead, step #3, and the 1 A bead, step #4 or the 2 A beads, step #10. Continue with working thread by following the blue dotted line in the illustration, coming out with thread up through the 1 A bead, step #3, and the 1 A bead, step #4




6. a) Pick up 1B, go with thread left to right through the 1st and 2nd A beads, step #5.


- b) Pick up 1B, go with thread down through the 3rd and 4th A beads, step #5.
- c) Pick up 1B, go with thread right to left through the 5th and 6th A beads, step #5.
- d) Pick up 1B, go with thread up through the 1 A bead, step #3, and the 1 A bead, step #4 or the 2 A beads, step #10, left to right through the 1 B bead added in this step at (a), the 1st and 2nd A beads, step #5.



7. Pick up 2A, go with thread left to right through the 1st A bead, step #5, up and right to left through the 2nd A bead just added in this step, left to right through the 1st and 2nd A beads, step #5, down through the 1 B bead, step #6b, and the 3rd and 4th A beads, step #5.




8. Pick up 2A, go with thread down through the 3rd A bead, step #5, up through the 2nd A bead just added in this step, down through the 3rd and 4th A beads step #5, down through the 1 B bead, step #6c, and right to left through the 5th and 6th A beads, step #5.




9. Pick up 2A, go with thread right to left through the 5th A bead, step #5, left to right through the 2nd A bead just added in this step and right to left through the 5th and 6th A beads, step #5. Continue

with working thread by following the blue dotted line in illustration, coming out with thread up through the 2 A beads, step #8.



10. Pick up 2A, go with thread up through the 1st A bead, step #8, down through the 2nd A bead just added in this step, up through the 2 A beads, step #8, and down through the 2 A beads just added in this step.



11. Continue bracelet by repeating step #5 through #10 until the bracelet is the length that you would like. Add closures as shown starting on page #17. Please note: In order to start the repeat of step #5, you have to flip over the bracelet so that you are coming out at the top of the stack. After finishing add the closure of your choice.

5. a) Pick up 2C, go with thread left to right through the 2 C beads, step #2b.

b) Pick up 2C, go with thread left to right through the 2 C beads, step #2c, and the A bead in FB.


c) Pick up 2C, go with thread left to right through the A bead in FB as shown and the 1st and 2nd C beads, step #2d.

d) Pick up 2C, go with thread left to right through the 5th and 6th C beads, step #2d.

e) Pick up 3C, go with thread left to right through the 2 C beads, step #3a.


f) Pick up 2C, go with thread left to right through the 2 C beads, step #3b, and the A bead in FB.

g) Pick up 2C, go with thread left to right through the A bead in FB as shown and the 1st and 2nd C beads, step #3c.



h) Continue to repeat steps #5d, #5e, #5f and #5g to the other end. Continue forward through the 1st and 2nd C beads, step #3g.

i) Pick up 4C, add a closure following the instructions starting on page #17. Pick up another 2 C beads and go with thread through the 2nd and 3rd C beads, step #3h. Continue with thread through the FB, coming out with thread right to left through the 2 C beads, step #4a.



6. a) Pick up 2C, go with thread right to left through the 2 C beads, step #4b.

b) Pick up 2C, go with thread right to left through the 2 C beads, step #4c, and the A bead in FB.


c) Pick up 2C, go with thread right to left through the A bead in FB as shown and the 1st and 2nd C beads, step #4d.

d) Pick up 2C, go with thread right to left through the 5th and 6th C beads, step #4d.

e) Pick up 3C, go with thread right to left through the 2 C beads, step #4e.

f) Pick up 2C, go with thread right to left through the 2 C beads, step #4f, and the A bead in FB.

g) Pick up 2C, go with thread right to left through the A bead in FB as shown and the 1st and 2nd C beads, step #4g.



h) Continue to repeat steps #6d, #6e, #6f and #6g to the other end. Continue forward through the 1st and 2nd C beads, step #4k.

i) Pick up 4C, add a closure following the instructions starting on page #17. Pick up another 2 C beads and go with thread through the 2nd and 3rd C beads, step #41. Weave the working threads into the bracelet and end.


Peyote Lace Bracelet 5





A = 10° Triangle bead, 10 grams


B = 4 mm Crystal, 20 crystals



1. Make 2 Peyote Lace Foundation Bracelet.




2. Flip every other section over vertically so all the sections are facing the same way. Lay them together as shown in the illustration.




3. In this step you will be weaving together top and bottom piece using the peyote stitch. Go with working thread from the bottom FB and weave through the first section. Work your way up left to right through the top beads in the bottom piece, going through the 1st and 2nd A beads. Continue and go through the 1st bottom A bead in the top piece, the 4th A bead in the bottom piece, the 3rd A bead in the top piece, the 6th A bead in the bottom piece, and the 5th A bead in

the top piece. Pick up 4A, go through the 2nd top A bead in the next section of the bottom, the 1st bottom A bead in the top piece, the 4th A bead in the bottom piece, the 3rd A bead in the top piece, the 6th A bead in the bottom piece, and the 5th A bead in the top piece. Please refer to the illustration for reference. Remember you are joining these pieces with peyote stich.



4. Continue by repeating step #3 to the other end.



5. This step shows you how to prepare the end of your bracelet to add the closure. Go with working thread forward through the last A bead in the top FB piece. I made a circle of 6A beads and then added the closure following the instructions on page #17. Continue with working thread through the center of your bracelet, going through all the beads that you went through in step #2 and #3. Weave the working threads into the bracelet and end.
